

## A range of requirements

We welcome students from many different countries and backgrounds. Requirements vary by programme – your grades, type of diploma, resumé, and motivation will be considered for acceptance.

IB	When applying please ensure that the levels of all subject, including the language-related ones, are clearly indicated (HL,SL, A or B, etc.)
A-Levels	A minimum of 3 (international) approved A-levels in general academic subjects

## English requirements

TOEFL IBT	<b>90</b> (20 per sub-score)
IELTS	<b>6.5</b> (6.0 per sub-score)
Cambridge Exam	CAE: <b>C</b> / CPE: <b>C</b>

If you are a native English speaker or hold an International or European Baccalaureate, you generally do not have to take an English test.
